This one day event was developed to share the New York City Fire Department's best team-building practices with corporations. You will have the rare opportunity to experience the FDNY's state-of-the-art training simulators to strengthen your teamwork skills. Teamwork

FDNY will provide real training exercises that firefighters use everyday to improve teamwork enabling them to save countless lives.

Leadership

FDNY will put individuals into challenging scenarios and have their leadership ability tested.

Problem Solving & Decision Making

FDNY will place teams in complex and high pressure environments requiring them to make insightful decisions under stress.

Communication Skills

FDNY will present different evolutions to communicate effectively when visibility and hearing are impaired.

Unconscious Firefighter

Firefighters have to sometimes rescue their own members. In this scenario, we take participants outside their normal elements in order to test their leadership and teamwork skills. They learn how to keep their cool under pressure and create order out of chaos.

Terrorist Bus Bombing

In today's world, the FDNY faces a new form of threat from terrorist attacks. In this scenario participants, learn about situational awareness. They need to identify potential threats and access the scene to determine if it is safe to approach.



Motivational Alley

Firefighters rely heavily on their team especially when operating a hose line. The nozzle person is reliant on their team to take the pressure off the hose and make sure the hose does not kink. This scenario, we teach participants how important it is to work together as a team and how to motivate your team for success.

Rescue Extrication

This evolution is designed to simulate trapped victims in a car after an accident through the use of effective communication the participants work as a team to free the victims as quickly and safely as possible.

Subway Rescue

When the FDNY responds to a subway incident, they need to make split second decisions in a high-stakes moment. This evolution is designed to show participants how to make quicker decision in a high-stakes moment.

Car Fire

FDNY firefighters work together to extinguish a car fire in order to save the victim as quickly as possible. In this evolution, participants learn how to work as a team. They need to work together in order to extinguish the flame as quickly as possible.



Forcible Entry

In order to get to the victims, firefighters need to access the building. In this evolution participants work as a team to break down the door. This activity cannot be done by one person. They need to work together and communicate in order to achieve the objective.

Structure Fire

Participants experience first hand what FDNY firefighters encounters on a daily basis. This is where we pull everything together in a live fire simulation under strong supervision of the fire department officers. Participants will use their teamwork, leadership, decision making and communication skills to complete this task.
